- ANNOUNCEMENT:** West Leeds Motor Club will organise an Open Trial for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Restricted to registered members of the ACU. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU Trials Registration /Membership or a SACU licence or ACU/SACU rider's licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance.
- MACHINES:** Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos; and TSR 8.
- CLASSES:** Novice and Youth A,B,C classes.
- START / VENUE:** 13:00pm Post Hill SE244 336, entrance to Post Hill off Wood Lane, 100yds from A6110 Ring Road, Farnley, B6154 Pudsey Road roundabout. Lat/Long 53.798019,-1.629483. No fuel, refreshments or toilets. No engines before start time.

- COURSE:** Varied terrain consisting of wooded hillside, quarry area, stream, rocks, and gullies. The event is on private land and must not be revisited. 4 laps of 10 sections, total mileage 4/5 miles. Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.
- METHOD of MARKING:** TSR 22a. Stop permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23
- PROTESTS:** as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU, section 10.04

I understand that this form may be used in litigation as evidence that any serious injury will be principally the result of my voluntary decision to engage in a high risk activity.
- I consent to details of any injuries I may suffer at this event being passed between all medical services and the Clerk of the Course.
- I have read and understood **The Auto Cycle Union Ltd Data Protection Policy** and consent to the collection and retention of my personal information by the ACU.
- I confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I shall participate on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose. I confirm that I am eligible to compete on the machines for which I have entered.
- I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
- I accept responsibility for any items borrowed from the Organiser during the course of the event. These items include but are not restricted to (safety clothing, transponders, accessories). I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.
