- ANNOUNCEMENT:** West Leeds Motor Club will organise a Club Restricted Trial on for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Regulations of the ACU, the Yorkshire Centre Rules current at the time, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting.
- ELIGIBILITY:** Restricted to registered members of West Leeds Motor Club Ltd. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU / SACU Trials Registration card or ACU/SACU competition licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance.
- MACHINES:** Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.
- CLASSES:** Exp, Int, Nov, Youth A,B,C,D and E, Over 40's Over 50's, Over 60's, Pre65 Twin-Shock, Clubman, Beginners.
- START / VENUE :** 13:00 Post Hill SE244 336, entrance to Post Hill off Wood Lane, 100yds from A6110 Ring Road, Farnley, B6154 Pudsey Road roundabout.

- ENTRIES:** Must be on the form provided on the day up to 1 hour before the Start. Entry Fee(s):
£15 for seniors, £10 for juniors, £5 for small wheels D and E class.
- RESULTS:** Will be published on club website: www.westleeds.co.uk as soon as practicable following the event. If you require a printed copy of results, please include with your entry a self addressed envelope.
- AWARDS:** There are no individual or event awards as event is part of Club Championship. Points will awarded at each of the events throughout the year to finishing positions in each class. The person with the most points in the class will be the Champion and will receive a Trophy with a replica. There will be 1st Class awards based on the remainder of finishers in the class. A 'Triers Bowl' is also awarded annually.
- COURSE:** All on private land, consisting of hilly woodland, rocky quarry, soft bottomed streams and muddy areas. Sections shall be ridden in correct order on each lap. The onus on finding the sections is that of the competitor, the route will be clearly marked and should be closely followed.
- MARKING METHOD:** As per TSR 22a; stop permitted. Ties will be resolved as per TSR 23
- PROTESTS:** as per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section 10.04.
- GENERAL:** Post Hill is a sensitive area with two ROW footpaths, both subject to the requirements of WLMC Ltd and requires you to ride with care and consideration.
