



### ANNOUNCEMENT:

The West Leeds Motor Club Ltd. will organise a National Trial on Sunday 13<sup>th</sup> September 2020 for solo motorcycles, held under the National Sporting Code, Standing Trials Regulations of the ACU, the following Supplementary Regulations and any final instructions issued for the meeting. Three classes for Adults: White Rose Course, 50/50 & Clubman's course. (There will be dual sections to accommodate Clubman and 50/50 course riders).

### ELIGIBILITY:

Open to all members of ACU Affiliated Clubs. All riders and passengers must hold a current ACU / SACU Trials Registration card or ACU/SACU competition licence. Any rider or passenger from another FMN MUST produce a licence issued by their FMN together with start permission and proof of personal accident Insurance.

### MACHINES:

Motorcycles as per NSC Appendix D Category 1, Group A1 Solos and TSR 8.

### START/VENUE:

Start 10am at CAM HEAD, NR. HAWES. (A684 through Gayle). NORTH YORKSHIRE. Long/Lat: 54.244926 / - 2.266682. Riders will start at 10.01 in pairs (socially distanced) at one minute intervals. Clubman riders will start first followed by White Rose riders and 50/50 riders last. Rider numbers and start times will be posted on web site and to riders supplying an SAE for that purpose.

### ENTRIES:

Pre-entry only online via ACU Event Entry System. (Ensure your details on the ACU website are 100% correct as this will be the only method of contact) Entries will close 6/9/2020. Entries will be limited to 150 on a first come basis. Only those who fulfil the Eligibility criteria will be allowed to enter. You will be notified of your entry acceptance by email. Instructions how to obtain your riding number and register at the event will also be sent. Entry Fee(s): - £31.00

### COVID 19:

The event will be run under the current guidelines issued by the Government and the ACU and must be adhered to.

**Travel to Event and Parking:** Only one person should travel in a vehicle unless from same household. Parking must be such that social distancing requirements are implemented at all times especially during unloading / loading.

**Parking at Sections:** On arrival at a section all riders must observe social distancing and MUST not park or queue near another rider.

**Inspecting Section:** Only three riders allowed in section at any time to inspect it without lingering. A one-way route walking the section as to be ridden, with social distancing to be strictly adhered to by riders passing other riders in section.

**General:** Please follow all signage and instructions. Failure to comply will result in you been asked to leave the venue.

### COURSE:

The course will consist of one lap and 40 sections in and around Hawes accessed by public highway. The Time limit for the event will be allocated with your start time. Time penalties will be incurred 1 mark per minute up to a maximum of 20 minutes for late starting and late finishing and thereafter will be disqualified. A part of the course will be passing by a Red Squirrel Conservation area at grid ref SD827 872 for approx 1 mile. There will be signs warning of this area. Please ride with extreme care at this point as there may also be young children about.

### METHOD OF MARKING:

As per TSR22b; No-stop. Ties will be resolved as per TSR23.

### PROTESTS:

As per the National Sporting Code of the ACU section10.04.

### GENERAL:

Two Cans of Petrol will be necessary. Fill up after first leg at car park. A petrol stop area will be signed, you will pass this on the road to the start, at which you may deposit one can of petrol; the course will pass this area. (There will be NO transport of fuel around the course). There will be a catering van at the start area for refreshments.

### RTA COVER:

Through the ACU Road Traffic Act Insurance Scheme, 3rd Party RTA insurance will be available at the start for competitors who are able to meet the requirements specified by the insurance company. (No additional charge will be levied for this cover). The machine which is entered and competed on must be suitable and proper for its purpose, shall be road legal and that it will comply with the regulations in respect thereof. All machines must display a number plate.
